Catholic and divorced—Rita Deniger is a life-long Catholic, youngest of a Catholic family of eleven children, mother of four, step-mother of five, and grandmother of seven and counting! She spent over twenty years as an Assistant Professor in Public Health and Family Life, and had a UW Extension radio program called “Family Matters”. She was one of the first people to start up Employee Wellness Programs. She is a past executive director of a Battered Women’s Shelter, a former family financial adviser, and worked eight years for the La Crosse Diocesan newspaper. She has done public speaking most of her life on numerous family and/or faith topics. She is a former Family Concerns Commission chair for the La Crosse DCCW and keynote speaker for the DCCW annual meeting in 1995. She was also a speaker on “Domestic Violence” at the NCCW assembly in Portland Maine.

As author of the book “A Rose Among the Thorns: Betrayal, Divorce and Legalized Harassment” Rita will use her own personal and professional experiences to share what she lived
